Marine Anchors and Systems

Marine anchors are required for all containment boom and turbidity curtain projects, regardless of the site's water conditions. More rigorous environmental and current conditions demand additional anchoring. The style of anchor can also be important, as each type has been designed for specific conditions. Proper implementation significantly reduces stress and redistributes weight throughout the floating barrier, alleviating strain, ensuring placement, and increasing the lifespan of the floating barrier. Standard Anchoring System

- Two Modified Danforth-style Anchors with 3/8" chains & shackles (Anchors available in 20 lbs. or 40 lbs.)
- One 12" Hard-skinned Mooring Buoy
- Two Extra Large Red Inflatable Marker Buoys
- One spool of 1/2" polypropylene rope (500 ft.)
- One spool of 1/4" polypropylene rope (500 ft.)

Snatch blocks, tie bridles and other anchoring accessories available. Components are also available for purchase individually.


Floating Barrier & Curtain Anchor Kit

- Danforth-style Anchors with 5/16" chain & shackles (Anchors available in 18 lbs. or 25 lbs.)
- 1/2" poly anchor line
- 3/8" poly retrieval buoy
- I/2" poly bridle line
- Thimble rope



Tow Bridles

Tow bridles are used during boom and turbidity curtain installation. They attach the floating barrier to the towboat, redistributing the pulled weight load to more than one point. Tow bridles prevent damage and stress on the barrier during the deployment process.



Tow Bridle

- Handles and joins containment booms
- Available with or without floats
- · Helps reduce damage to boom

Standard Tow/Tie Off Bridle

- Full height to match containment boom coupler

- Mini boom tow bridles available



Floating Marker Lights

Floating marker lights increase the visibility of curtain or boom while deployed in the water. Every marker light includes a light, pole, and buoy, allowing it to float next to the barrier. These marker lights ensure the safe navigation of boats and ships in harbors and marinas. Our floating marker lights also comply with most demarcation regulations on the local and state level.

Marker Buoys

Marker buoys are used to indicate the locations of turbidity curtain and boom anchors. Designed for commercial use, transportation and infraestructure departments often use them in city harbors, smaller public marinas, and boat docks. In addition to their primary purpose, marker buoys can also be deployed as demarcation guides and mooring signals.

- 8 Wheel- Rises and falls with the tide on any 4' I-Beam Designed for permanent installations
